CHAPTER _____

2 **State Government - Maryland Veterans Commission - Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of adding a member of the Colonial Chapter of the Paralyzed
4 Veterans of America to the Maryland Veterans Commission; and generally
5 relating to the Maryland Veterans Commission.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

2 9-905.

3 There is a Maryland Veterans Commission in the Department.

4 9-907.

5 (a) (1) The Commission consists of the following [30] 31 members:

6 (i) as an ex officio member, the Chairman of the Maryland
7 Veterans' Home Commission; and

8 (ii) [29] 30 members appointed by the Governor.

9 (2) Of the [29] 30 appointed members:

10 (i) 1 shall be appointed from each of the 8 congressional districts in
11 the State;12 (ii) 1 shall be a veteran of World War II, appointed from the State
13 at large;14 (iii) 1 shall be a representative of a women veterans organization in
15 the State;16 (iv) 1 shall be appointed from a list of individuals submitted to the
17 Governor by each of the following organizations:

18 1. the American Ex-Prisoners of War, Inc.;

19 2. the American Legion;

20 3. the Amvets;

21 4. the Catholic War Veterans;

22 5. the Disabled American Veterans;

23 6. the Fleet Reserve Association;

24 7. the Jewish War Veterans;

25 8. the Marine Corps League;

26 9. the Maryland Retired Officers Association;

27 10. the Military Order of the Purple Heart;

28 11. the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association;

29 12. the Polish Legion of American Veterans;

- 1 13. the Veterans of Foreign Wars;
- 2 14. the Vietnam Veterans of America;
- 3 15. the Korean War Veterans Association, Inc.;
- 4 16. the Black Veterans of All Wars, Inc.;
- 5 17. the Maryland Coalition of the Retired Enlisted
- 6 Association; [and]
- 7 18. the Veterans of the Battle of the Bulge; and
- 8 19. THE COLONIAL CHAPTER OF THE PARALYZED VETERANS
- 9 OF AMERICA; AND

10 (v) 1 shall be a veteran of the Persian Gulf War appointed from the

11 State at large.

12 (b) Each member must be a resident of the State and a veteran whose final

13 separation from active service with a uniformed service of the United States was

14 under honorable conditions.

15 (c) (1) The term of an appointed member is 7 years.

16 (2) The terms of the appointed members are staggered as required by the

17 terms provided for members of the Commission on October 1, 1984.

18 (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is

19 appointed and qualifies.

20 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for

21 the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

23 October 1, 2006.
