22	(a) This section applies to an individual who:
23 24	(1) retired from the Employees' Pension System on or after January 1, 1996, under § 23-404 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article;
25 26	(2) is receiving a service retirement allowance from the Employees' Pension System on June 30, 2006; and
27 28	(3) was appointed as a member of the State Workers' Compensation Commission on or after January 1, 2004.
