Requirements and Delay of Sale

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Port Administration to submit a
- 5 cost-benefit analysis of the sale of the World Trade Center and a certain number
- of appraisals of the World Trade Center completed by certain independent
- 7 entities to the General Assembly on or before a certain date; prohibiting the
- 8 Department of Transportation from entering into a contract for the sale of the
- 9 World Trade Center before a certain date; making this Act an emergency bill;
- and generally relating to the sale of the World Trade Center.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That:

1 AN ACT concerning

- 13 (a) In accordance with Chapter 443 of the Acts of the General Assembly of
- 14 2005, on or before June 1, 2006, the Maryland Port Administration shall submit the
- 15 following to the General Assembly in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State
- 16 Government Article:
- 17 (1) A cost-benefit analysis of the sale of the World Trade Center; and
- 18 (2) Two appraisals of the World Trade Center completed by entities
- 19 independent from the Maryland Department of Transportation.
- 20 (b) The Department of Transportation may not enter into a contract to sell the
- 21 World Trade Center before June 1, 2007.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 23 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
- 24 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
- 25 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 26 the date it is enacted.
