SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 19

20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Public Utility Companies** 21

22 SUBTITLE 8. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A PERSON THAT ENGAGES IN ONE OR MORE OF 24 (A)

- 1 (1) PROVIDING HEATING, VENTILATION, AIR-CONDITIONING, OR
- 2 REFRIGERATION SERVICES, AS DEFINED IN § 9A-101 OF THE BUSINESS REGULATION
- 3 ARTICLE, TO RESIDENTIAL OR COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS;
- 4 (2) PROVIDING PLUMBING SERVICES, AS DEFINED IN § 12-101 OF THE
- 5 BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE, TO RESIDENTIAL OR
- 6 COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS;
- 7 (3) PROVIDING HOME IMPROVEMENTS, AS DEFINED IN § 8-101 OF THE
- 8 BUSINESS REGULATION ARTICLE, TO RESIDENTIAL OR COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS;
- 9 (4) INSTALLING, MAINTAINING, OR REPAIRING APPLIANCES, INCLUDING

- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to
- 24 any trade name or trademark used on or after the effective date of this Act, regardless
- 25 of whether the person used the trade name or trademark prior to the effective date of
- 26 this Act.
- 27 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That an obligation or contract
- 28 right that exists before the effective date of this Act may not be impaired in any way
- 29 by this Act.
- 30 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 31 November 1, 2006.
