30	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to any trade name or trademark used on or after the effective date of this Act October 1, 2007, regardless of whether the person used the trade name or trademark prior to the effective date of this Act.
	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That an obligation or contract right that exists before the effective date of this Act may not be impaired in any way by this Act.
