# A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Creation of a State Debt - Montgomery County - Poolesville Town Hall

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$275,000,

the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Commissioners of the Town of 4

5 Poolesville for certain development or improvement purposes; providing for

disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee 6

7 provide and expend a matching fund; establishing a deadline for the

encumbrance or expenditure of the loan proceeds; and providing generally for 8

the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan. 9

#### SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10 11 MARYLAND, That:

12 (1)The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on

13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Montgomery

14 County - Poolesville Town Hall Loan of 2006 in a total principal amount equal to the 15 lesser of (i) \$275,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance

16 with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and

17 delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of

18 Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through

19 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.

20 (2)The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as 21 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under 22 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

23 The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer (3)24 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and 25 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then 26 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the 27 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable 28 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Commissioners of the Town of 29 Poolesville (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning, design, 30 construction, and capital equipping of the Poolesville Town Hall, located in

31 Poolesville.

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1 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in

2 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as and

3 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years

4 after the date of issuance of the bonds.

5 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the 6 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a

7 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either

8 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or

9 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind

 $10\,$  contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any

11 dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify

12 as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the

13 Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2008, to present evidence

14 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If

15 satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of

16 the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the 17 amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act.

17 amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. 18 Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the

19 Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

20 (6) The proceeds of the loan must be expended or encumbered by the Board of

21 Public Works for the purposes provided in this Act no later than June 1, 2013. If any

22 funds authorized by this Act remain unexpended or unencumbered after June 1,

23 2013, the amount of the unencumbered or unexpended authorization shall be

24 canceled and be of no further effect. If bonds have been issued for the loan, the

25 amount of unexpended or unencumbered bond proceeds shall be disposed of as

26 provided in § 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28 June 1, 2006.

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
