3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Office of Student Financial Assistance to waive or
4 forgive a certain grant award for a part-time nurse at a certain rate; and
5 generally relating to the waiver or forgiveness of a grant award for a part-time
6 nurse.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 (g) (1) The Office shall waive the repayment of a grant award for a:

6 (i) Full-time nurse at the rate of 1 year for each year that the
7 recipient performs the service obligation; or8 (ii) Part-time nurse at the rate of [2 years] ONE-HALF YEAR for
9 each year that the recipient performs the service obligation.10 (2) The repayment of the grant award by a recipient who is not yet
11 required by the provisions of this subtitle to begin repayment of the grant award and
12 who accepts employment that fulfills the service obligation shall be forgiven, for the
13 purposes of this subtitle, for a:14 (i) Full-time nurse at the rate of 1 year for each year that the
15 recipient performs the service obligation; or16 (ii) Part-time nurse at the rate of [2 years] ONE-HALF YEAR for
17 each year that the recipient performs the service obligation.18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2006.
