CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Class C License in Highlandtown Arts**
3 **and Entertainment District**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of Liquor License Commissioners of
5 Baltimore City to issue a Class C beer, wine and liquor license for use by a
6 certain person in a certain area; providing for the termination of this Act; and
7 generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Baltimore City.

8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
9 MARYLAND, That, notwithstanding any provision of Article 2B of the Code, the
10 Board of Liquor License Commissioners of Baltimore City may issue one Class C beer,
11 wine and liquor license for use by an arts club that has been incorporated less than 5
12 years and is located on Highland Avenue in the Highlandtown Arts and
13 Entertainment District.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 June 1, 2006. It shall remain effective for a period of 7 months and, at the end of
16 December 31, 2006, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act
17 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
