1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 (a) The provisions of this section apply except as necessary to avoid conflict 6 with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or 7 traffic control device.

8 (e) A person may not stop, stand, or park a vehicle on a crosswalk.
