- 14 (a) A child who is [16] 14 years old or older and who is subject to a custody 15 order or decree may file a petition to change custody.
- 16 (b) A petitioner under this section may file the proceeding in the petitioner's 17 own name and need not proceed by guardian or next friend.
- 18 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, if a petitioner under 19 this section petitions a court to amend a custody order or decree, the court:
- 20 (1) shall hold a hearing; and
- 21 (2) may amend the order or decree and place the child in the custody of
- 22 the parent designated by the child.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
