10 Preamble

- WHEREAS, Dating from 2600 B.C., the Asian lunar calendar is the oldest
- 12 calendar on earth and the longest chronological record in history; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The new year on the Asian lunar calendar begins at the second
- 14 lunar month after the winter solstice; and
- WHEREAS, The lunar new year is a time of commemoration, celebration, and
- 16 deep meaning for millions of people throughout the world, including people in the
- 17 United States and the State of Maryland; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The lunar new year is of particular significance to countless
- 19 Americans, especially numerous Asian Americans, including those of Chinese,
- 20 Korean, and Vietnamese descent now living in Maryland; and
- 21 WHEREAS, The many individuals who celebrate the lunar new year have
- 22 greatly enriched the nation and the State of Maryland; now, therefore,
- 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 24 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
