- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 22 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

- SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THERE SHALL BE 24 (A)
- 25 INCLUDED IN THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE JUDICIARY AN AUTHORIZATION TO THE
- 26 ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT NECESSARY TO
- 27 REIMBURSE COUNTIES THAT PROVIDE THE CIRCUIT COURT WITH SECURITY IN

- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act does not relieve
- 6 any county or sheriff of the duty to provide security to the circuit court for the county.
- 7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be
- 8 construed to assume any liability incurred by any county in connection with security
- 9 for the circuit court for the county and, except as specifically provided in this Act, does
- 10 not modify any existing duty or liability of the State or a county.

11 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- 12 (1) Beginning in fiscal year 2008 and in each subsequent fiscal year,
- 13 each county shall use the local fiscal savings resulting from this Act, if any, for the
- 14 sole purpose of increasing local expenditures for circuit court or related public safety
- 15 purposes;
- 16 (2) In fiscal years 2008 through 2015, each county shall report to the
- 17 Department of Budget and Management on or before November 1 on circuit court or
- 18 related public safety expenditures to which the savings resulting from this Act have
- 19 been applied. The Department of Budget and Management shall report these
- 20 expenditures to the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals and, subject to § 2-1246 of the
- 21 State Government Article, to the General Assembly; and
- 22 (3) Circuit court or public safety related expenditures required under
- 23 this section shall be used to supplement, and may not supplant, existing local
- 24 expenditures for the same purpose.
- 25 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 July 1, 2007.
