## 2 Election Law - Petition Verification

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that the purpose of verification of signatures on certain
- 4 petitions is to ensure that the name of the individual who signed the petition is
- 5 listed as a registered voter; making this Act an emergency measure; and

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Election Law
- 15 6-207.
- 16 (a) Upon the filing of a petition, and unless it has been declared deficient
- 17 under § 6-206 of this subtitle, the staff of the election authority shall proceed to verify
- 18 the signatures and count the validated signatures contained in the petition.
- 19 (2) THE PURPOSE OF SIGNATURE VERIFICATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)
- 20 OF THIS SUBSECTION IS TO ENSURE THAT THE NAME OF THE INDIVIDUAL WHO
- 21 SIGNED THE PETITION IS LISTED AS A REGISTERED VOTER.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an
- 23 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health
- 24 or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the
- 25 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take
- 26 effect from the date it is enacted.
