16 (a) (1) Upon the filing of a petition, and unless it has been declared deficient 17 under § 6-206 of this subtitle, the staff of the election authority shall proceed to verify 18 the signatures and count the validated signatures contained in the petition.

- 8 effect from the date it is enacted.
