- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) NOTWITHSTANDING § 8-710 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL
- 19 ISSUE A PROCLAMATION ORDERING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL A VACANCY IN
- 20 OFFICE FOR A REPRESENTATIVE IN CONGRESS IF:

- 1 (1) THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ANNOUNCES
- 2 THAT VACANCIES IN THE REPRESENTATION FROM THE STATES IN THE HOUSE
- 3 EXCEED 100;
- 4 (2) ONE OR MORE OF THOSE VACANCIES INCLUDE REPRESENTATIVES
- 5 IN CONGRESS FROM MARYLAND; AND
- 6 (3) THERE IS NO REGULARLY SCHEDULED ELECTION DURING THE 7 75-DAY PERIOD FOLLOWING THE SPEAKER'S ANNOUNCEMENT.
- 8 (B) THE SPECIAL ELECTION SHALL BE HELD 49 DAYS AFTER THE SPEAKER OF
- 9 THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ANNOUNCES THAT VACANCIES IN THE
- 10 REPRESENTATION FROM THE STATES IN THE HOUSE EXCEED 100.
- 11 (C) THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS
- 12 ESTABLISHING THE PROCEDURES FOR CONDUCTING THE SPECIAL ELECTION.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 14 effect July 1, 2006.
