- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (a) When registered with the Administration, every passenger car and station
- 16 wagon, except as otherwise provided in this part, is a Class A (passenger) vehicle.
- 17 (b) [For] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, FOR
- 18 each Class A (passenger) vehicle, the annual registration fee is:
- 19 (1) For a vehicle with a manufacturer's shipping weight of 3,700 pounds
- 20 or less \$50.50; and
- 21 (2) For a vehicle with a manufacturer's shipping weight of more than

- 23 (C) FOR EACH CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE OWNED BY AN INDIVIDUAL

- 17 (1) For a vehicle with a manufacturer's shipping weight of 3,700 pounds
- 18 or less \$50.50; and
- 19 (2) For a vehicle with a manufacturer's shipping weight of more than 20 3,700 pounds \$76.50.
- 21 (c) FOR EACH CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE OWNED BY AN INDIVIDUAL
- 22 WHO IS AT LEAST 65 YEARS OF AGE, THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE IS:
- 23 (1) FOR A VEHICLE WITH A MANUFACTURER'S SHIPPING WEIGHT OF
- 24 3,700 POUNDS OR LESS \$27.00; AND
- 25 (2) FOR A VEHICLE WITH A MANUFACTURER'S SHIPPING WEIGHT OF
- 26 MORE THAN 3,700 POUNDS \$40.50.
- 27 (D) The Administration may by rule and regulation provide for the registration
- 28 under this section of all multipurpose passenger vehicles registered under another

- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 31 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have
- 32 any effect on or application to any registration fee paid or due to be paid before the
- 33 effective date of this Act.

- 35 July 1, 2006.
