1 AN ACT concerning

State Board of Morticians - Sunset Extension and Program Evaluation

3 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Program

4 Evaluation Act, this title and all rules and regulations adopted under this title shall

5 terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [2008] 2018.

Article - State Government

7 8-403.

8 (a) On or before December 15 of the 2nd year before the evaluation date of a 9 governmental activity or unit, the Legislative Policy Committee, based on a 10 preliminary evaluation, may waive as unnecessary the evaluation required under this 11 section.

12 (b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (a) of this section, on or before 13 the evaluation date for the following governmental activities or units, an evaluation 14 shall be made of the following governmental activities or units and the statutes and 15 regulations that relate to the governmental activities or units:
