A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Cecil County - Property Tax Credit - American Legion Mason-Dixon**
3 **Post 194**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the governing body of Cecil County and a municipal
5 corporation in Cecil County to grant a property tax credit against the county and
6 municipal corporation property tax imposed on property that is owned by the
7 American Legion Mason-Dixon Post 194 and is used for a certain purpose;
8 providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to a property tax
9 credit for property that is owned by the American Legion Mason-Dixon Post
10 194.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Tax - Property**

19 9-309.

20 (a) The governing body of Cecil County and of a municipal corporation in Cecil
21 County shall grant a property tax credit under this section against the county and
22 municipal corporation property tax imposed on:

23 (1) property that is owned by the Society for the Preservation of
24 Maryland Antiquities, Incorporated; [and]

25 (2) property that is owned by the Friends of the Library of Cecil County,
26 Maryland, Incorporated; AND

1 (3) PROPERTY THAT IS OWNED BY THE AMERICAN LEGION
2 MASON-DIXON POST 194, USED AS ATHLETIC FIELDS EXCLUSIVELY FOR AMATEUR
3 SPORTS.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 June 1, 2006, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30,
6 2006.
