29 TRANSMITTED IS DISCLOSED IN THE SERVICE AGREEMENT; OR

30 (6) FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING THE NEED FOR OR

1(2)(I)PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A2PERSON WHO RETRIEVES DATA DISCLOSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION3(C)(5) OF THIS SECTION.

4 (II) A PERSON DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION
5 MAY RELEASE DATA RETRIEVED FROM A VEHICLE'S RECORDING DEVICE, OTHER
6 THAN DATA THAT COULD DISCLOSE THE IDENTITY OF THE VEHICLE'S REGISTERED
7 OWNER OR DRIVER, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING RESEARCH INTO MOTOR
8 VEHICLE SAFETY, INCLUDING MEDICAL RESEARCH INTO HOW THE HUMAN BODY

15 OWNER'S MANUAL FOR THE VEHICLE THE FACT THAT THE VEHICLE IS SO EQUIPPED.
