- 21 (A) THERE IS A COMPREHENSIVE INDUCTION PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT
- 22 FOR NEW TEACHERS EMPLOYED BY HARD-TO-STAFF SCHOOLS, AS THAT TERM IS
- 23 DEFINED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 24 (B) THE COMPREHENSIVE INDUCTION PROGRAM SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT
- 25 BE LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING:
- 26 (1) MENTORING;
- 27 (2) PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING AND SUPPORT; AND

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- 1 (3) FORMAL ASSESSMENTS OF TEACHERS PARTICIPATING IN THE 2 PROGRAM.
- 3 $\,$ (C) $\,$ THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS 4 SECTION, INCLUDING:
- 5 (1) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR TEACHERS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 6 PROGRAM; AND
- 7 (2) THE STANDARDS TO DETERMINE WHICH SCHOOLS ARE CONSIDERED 8 HARD-TO-STAFF SCHOOLS.
- 9 (D) FUNDING FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE INDUCTION PROGRAM SHALL BE AS 10 PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2006.
