- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Education
- 19 7-425.
- 20 (A) FOR EACH HIGH SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY, A COUNTY BOARD SHALL
- 21 DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR PROGRAM
- 22 THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 13-517 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 23 (B) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 24 HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, THE MARYLAND STATE SCHOOL HEALTH COUNCIL,
- 25 AND THE MARYLAND INSTITUTE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES SYSTEMS.
- 26 SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT ASSIST COUNTY BOARDS IN CARRYING OUT THE
- 27 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 July 1, 2006.
