1 AN ACT concerning

2 **High Schools - Automated External Defibrillator Program - Requirement**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring each county board of education to develop and
4 implement a certain automated external defibrillator program that meets
5 certain requirements in high schools; requiring the State Department of
6 Education, in consultation with the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene,
7 the Maryland State School Health Council, and the Maryland Institute for
8 Emergency Medical Services Systems, to adopt certain regulations; and
9 generally relating to requiring high schools to have an automated external
10 defibrillator program.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Education**

19 7-425.

20 (A) FOR EACH HIGH SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY, A COUNTY BOARD SHALL
21 DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR PROGRAM
22 THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 13-517 OF THIS ARTICLE.

1 (B) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF
2 HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, THE MARYLAND STATE SCHOOL HEALTH COUNCIL,
3 AND THE MARYLAND INSTITUTE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES SYSTEMS,
4 SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT ASSIST COUNTY BOARDS IN CARRYING OUT THE
5 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 July 1, 2006.
