- 17 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN AN AREA WHERE THE POSTED MAXIMUM
- 18 SPEED LIMIT IS AT LEAST 40 MILES PER HOUR.
- 19 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT CAUSE THE DEATH OF ANOTHER WHILE DRIVING,
