12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Criminal Procedure**

16 (A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, ANY ORDER OF
17 RESTITUTION MADE BY A COURT SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
18 SUBTITLE.

19 (B) THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO LIMIT THE AUTHORITY OF A
20 COURT TO DIRECT A DEFENDANT OR A CHILD FOUND TO HAVE COMMITTED A
21 DELINQUENT ACT TO MAKE RESTITUTION OR TO PERFORM CERTAIN SERVICES, AS

1 SPECIFIED BY THE COURT, FOR THE VICTIM AS AN ALTERNATIVE MEANS OF
2 RESTITUTION.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 October 1, 2006.
