BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings** 15 2-309. (e) The Sheriff of Baltimore County shall receive [a salary of not more 16 (1)17 than \$70,000.] AN ANNUAL SALARY OF: 18 (I) \$75,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2007; 19 (II) \$80,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2008; 20 (III) \$85,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2009; AND \$90,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2010 AND EACH SUBSEQUENT 21 (IV)22 CALENDAR YEAR.

- 23 (2) The Sheriff shall appoint an under-sheriff and any number of
- 24 deputies and any clerical assistant required by the duties of the office. The Sheriff
- 25 may also appoint a number of deputies to the ranks of chief deputy, captain,

26 lieutenant, and sergeant as his duties and responsibilities require. The cost and

1 expense of these supervisory, administrative, and clerical positions, including

2 salaries, shall be as provided in the budget of the county by the County Executive and

3 as approved by the County Council. All full-time employees under this subsection are

4 subject to the provisions of the county merit system and the rules and regulations

5 passed by the County Council pursuant to the charter, as to qualifications,

6 compensation, and other regulations. Part-time deputies may not be employed by the

7 Sheriff's office. However, the Sheriff may appoint as part-time deputies persons

8 employed in specific plants, institutions, colleges, and hospitals situated within

9 Baltimore County who are limited to service only within the particular facility where

10 they are employed, and who may not be compensated by Baltimore County for their 11 services.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §

13 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to

14 the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Baltimore County in office on the effective

15 date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation

16 of the Sheriff of Baltimore County shall take effect at the beginning of the next

17 following term of office.

18 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 October 1, 2006.
