CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Community Colleges - Baltimore City Community College - Board of**
 3 **Trustees**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Board of Trustees of Baltimore
 5 City Community College; authorizing the Faculty Senate of Baltimore City
 6 Community College to elect a certain faculty member to the Board of Trustees;
 7 prohibiting a certain faculty member of the Board of Trustees from participating
 8 in certain executive sessions; providing for a certain term for a certain faculty
 9 member of the Board of Trustees; requiring the Board of Trustees to meet at
 10 certain times and certain places; and generally relating to the Board of Trustees
 11 of Baltimore City Community College.

12 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
 13 Article - Education
 14 Section 16-504(b), (c), and (f)
 15 Annotated Code of Maryland
 16 (2004 Replacement Volume and 2005 Supplement)

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article - Education**

20 16-504.

21 (b) (1) The Board of Trustees consists of THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:

1 (I) 9 members appointed by the Governor with the advice and
2 consent of the Senate; AND

3 (II) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, 1
4 NONVOTING FACULTY MEMBER ELECTED BY THE FACULTY SENATE.

5 (2) Of the APPOINTED members:

6 (i) Each shall be a resident of the State;

7 (ii) A majority shall be residents of Baltimore City; and

8 (iii) 1 shall be a regularly enrolled student in good standing at the
9 College.

10 (3) THE FACULTY MEMBER MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN AN EXECUTIVE
11 SESSION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES CONDUCTED TO DISCUSS PERSONNEL ISSUES.

12 (c) (1) The student member AND THE FACULTY MEMBER shall have a term
13 of 1 year beginning June 1 and ending on May 30.

14 (2) Except [for the student member,] AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (1)
15 OF THIS SUBSECTION, the term OF AN APPOINTED MEMBER is 6 years from July 1 of
16 the year of appointment and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

17 (3) The terms of the APPOINTED members are staggered, as required by
18 the terms provided for members of the Board OF TRUSTEES on July 1, 1992.

19 (4) A member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves
20 only for the remainder of that term or until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

21 (5) A member may be reappointed but may not serve more than 2
22 consecutive full terms.

23 (f) (1) (I) [The] SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH,
24 THE Board of Trustees shall meet regularly at such times and places as it determines.

25 (II) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONE TIME
26 EACH QUARTER WITH THE FACULTY SENATE AT SUCH TIMES AND PLACES AS THE
27 BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND THE FACULTY SENATE DETERMINE.

28 (2) The Board of Trustees may adopt rules for the conduct of its meetings
29 and the transaction of business.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
31 October 1, 2006.
