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## 1 Article - Health - General 2 18-110. <del>(A)</del> EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, ON OR 3 4 AFTER JANUARY 1, 2007, AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT BE VACCINATED WITH A VACCINE 5 THAT CONTAINS MORE THAN 1.25 MICROGRAMS OF MERCURY PER 0.5 MILLILITER 6 DOSE. 7 ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2008, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE VACCINATED WITH A 8 VACCINE THAT CONTAINS LESS THAN 1.25 MICROGRAMS OF MERCURY PER 0.5 9 MILLILITER DOSE UNLESS A VACCINE THAT MEETS THIS REQUIREMENT IS NOT 10 READILY AVAILABLE OR APPROPRIATE.
