3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Health Services Cost Review Commission, in  
4 consultation with the Maryland Health Care Commission, to publish certain  
5 information on hospital charges; and generally relating to hospital charges.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Health - General**

14 19-207.

15 (b) In addition to the duties set forth elsewhere in this subtitle, the  
16 Commission shall:

17 (1) Adopt rules and regulations that relate to its meetings, minutes, and  
18 transactions;

19 (2) Keep minutes of each meeting;

1 (3) Prepare annually a budget proposal that includes the estimated  
2 income of the Commission and proposed expenses for its administration and  
3 operation;

4 (4) Within a reasonable time after the end of each facility's fiscal year or  
5 more often as the Commission determines, prepare from the information filed with  
6 the Commission any summary, compilation, or other supplementary report that will  
7 advance the purposes of this subtitle;

8 (5) Periodically participate in or do analyses and studies that relate to:

9 (i) Health care costs;

10 (ii) The financial status of any facility; or

11 (iii) Any other appropriate matter;

12 (6) On or before October 1 of each year, submit to the Governor, to the  
13 Secretary, and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the General  
14 Assembly an annual report on the operations and activities of the Commission during  
15 the preceding fiscal year, including:

16 (i) A copy of each summary, compilation, and supplementary report  
17 required by this subtitle; and

18 (ii) Any other fact, suggestion, or policy recommendation that the  
19 Commission considers necessary; [and]

20 (7) Oversee and administer the Maryland Trauma Physician Services  
21 Fund in conjunction with the Maryland Health Care Commission; AND

22 (8) IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND HEALTH CARE  
23 COMMISSION, ANNUALLY PUBLISH EACH ACUTE CARE HOSPITAL'S  
24 SEVERITY-ADJUSTED AVERAGE CHARGE PER CASE FOR THE 15 MOST COMMON  
25 INPATIENT DIAGNOSIS-RELATED GROUPS.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
27 October 1, 2006.
