A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - School Board Districts - Composition**

3 FOR the purpose of making technical changes to the composition of the school board
4 districts in Prince George's County; providing for the effective date of this Act;
5 and generally relating to school board districts in Prince George's County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
7 Article - Education
8 Section 3-1001
9 Annotated Code of Maryland
10 (2004 Replacement Volume and 2005 Supplement)
11 (As enacted by Chapter 289 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Education**

15 3-1001.

16 (a) The descriptions of school board districts in this section are to the election
17 district and precinct boundaries as reviewed and certified by the Prince George's
18 County Board of Elections or their designees before they were reported to the United
19 States Bureau of the Census as part of the 2000 Census Redistricting Data Program
20 and as those election district and precinct lines are specifically shown on the Public
21 Law 94-171 census block maps provided by the United States Bureau of the Census.

22 (b) School board district I consists of:

- 23 (1) Election district 1;
- 24 (2) Election district 10;
- 25 (3) Election district 14, precincts 2, 7, and 8;
- 26 (4) Election district 20, precincts 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, and 9 through 11;

1 (5) Election district 21, precincts 3, 4, 6 through 11, 13, 14, and 16; and

2 (6) That part of election district 14, precinct 9 that consists of the
3 following census tracts and blocks:

4 (i) Census tract 8004.01, blocks 1000 through 1003; and

5 (ii) Census tract 8004.06, blocks 1000 through 1002, 1011, 1012,
6 1020 through 1028, 1999 through 2003, 2006 through 2010, 2017, 2023 through 2027,
7 2041 through 2048, 3000 through 3014, 3017, 3018, and 3068.

8 (c) School board district II consists of:

9 (1) Election district 2, precincts 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 10;

10 (2) Election district 16;

11 (3) Election district 17;

12 (4) Election district 19; and

13 (5) Election district 21, precincts 1, 2, 5, 12, 15, and 17.

14 (d) School board district III consists of:

15 (1) Election district 2, precincts 4 and 9;

16 (2) Election district 6, precincts 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 10, 11, 15, 16, and 19
17 through 23;

18 (3) Election district 13, precincts 1, 2, 3, 7, 8, 9, 10, 14, 16, and 17;

19 (4) Election district 15, precinct 2;

20 (5) Election district 18; and

21 (6) Election district 20, precincts [3, 4,] 4 and 8.

22 (e) School board district IV consists of:

23 (1) Election district 5, precincts 2 through 7;

24 (2) Election district 6, precincts 2, 7, 8, 9, 12, 13, 14, 17, and 18;

25 (3) Election district 9, precincts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 10, and 11; and

26 (4) Election district 12.

27 (f) School board district V consists of:

28 (1) Election district 3;

- 1 (2) Election district 4;
- 2 (3) Election district 5, precincts 1 and 8;
- 3 (4) Election district 7;
- 4 (5) Election district 8;
- 5 (6) Election district 9, precincts 6, 8, and 9;
- 6 (7) Election district 11;
- 7 (8) Election district 13, precincts 4, 5, 6, 11, 12, 13, and 15;
- 8 (9) Election district 14, precincts 1, 3 through 6, and 10;
- 9 (10) Election district 15, PRECINCTS 1, 3, AND 4; and
- 10 (11) That part of election district 14, precinct 9 that consists of census
11 tract 8004.06, blocks 2004, 2005, 2011 through 2016, 2018 through 2022, 2028
12 through 2040, 3015, 3016, 3019 through 3025, 3029 through 3035, 3054 through 3065,
13 and 3069.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 July 1, 2006, the effective date of Section 21 of Chapter 289 of the Acts of the General
16 Assembly of 2002. If the effective date of Section 21 of Chapter 289 is amended, this
17 Act shall take effect on the taking effect of Section 21 of Chapter 289.
