2 State Boards and Other Similar Bodies - Open Positions - Appointments 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor's Appointments Office to make available 4 to the public an announcement regarding each open position on a State board or 5 other similar body; requiring the Appointments Office to make an appointment to fill an open position on a State board or other similar body within a certain 6 time limit and to appoint only qualified individuals if the position requires 7 8 certain qualifications; establishing a certain penalty if the Appointments Office 9 fails to make an appointment to fill an open position on a State board or other similar body within a certain time limit; defining a certain term; and generally 10 relating to appointments made for open positions on State boards and other 11 similar bodies. 12 13 BY adding to 14 Article - State Government 15 Section 8-505 16 Annotated Code of Maryland 17 (2004 Replacement Volume and 2005 Supplement) 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 20 **Article - State Government** 21 8-505. 22 IN THIS SECTION, "OPEN POSITION" MEANS A POSITION THAT: (A) 23 IS VACANT ON A STATE BOARD, COMMISSION, TASK FORCE, (1)24 ADVISORY COUNCIL, ADVISORY COMMITTEE, OR OTHER SIMILAR BODY; 25 (2)REQUIRES APPOINTMENT BY THE GOVERNOR; AND

26 (3) DOES NOT RECEIVE A SALARY OR COMPENSATION BUT MAY RECEIVE

27 REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL

28 REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

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1 (B) THE GOVERNOR'S APPOINTMENTS OFFICE SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO 2 THE PUBLIC AN ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING EACH OPEN POSITION BY:

3 (1) POSTING A POSITION VACANCY OR JOB ANNOUNCEMENT ON THE 4 MARYLAND.GOV WEBSITE;

5 (2) POSTING A POSITION VACANCY OR JOB ANNOUNCEMENT ON THE 6 OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR'S WEBSITE;

7 (3) PRINTING ADVERTISEMENTS IN A MINIMUM OF TWO NEWSPAPERS
8 THAT EACH HAVE A DAILY TOTAL AVERAGE PAID CIRCULATION OF 200,000 OR MORE;
9 AND

(4) USING ANY OTHER METHOD THAT IS REASONABLY CALCULATED TO
 ENSURE A SUFFICIENT POOL OF APPLICANTS, INCLUDING PRINTING
 ADVERTISEMENTS IN JOURNALS, PAPER AND ELECTRONIC BULLETIN BOARD
 POSTINGS, AND SPECIAL NOTICES.

14 (C) IF AN OPEN POSITION REQUIRES SPECIFIC QUALIFICATIONS, THE
15 GOVERNOR'S APPOINTMENTS OFFICE SHALL APPOINT ONLY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO
16 MEETS THE SPECIFIC QUALIFICATIONS.

17 (D) THE GOVERNOR'S APPOINTMENTS OFFICE SHALL MAKE AN 18 APPOINTMENT:

19(1)FOR EACH NEW OPEN POSITION CREATED BY LEGISLATION, WITHIN2060 DAYS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE LEGISLATION; OR

(2) FOR EACH OPEN POSITION RESULTING FROM THE RESIGNATION,
 TERMINATION, OR DEATH OF A CURRENT MEMBER, WITHIN 60 DAYS OF THE
 RESIGNATION, TERMINATION, OR DEATH OF THE MEMBER.

(E) IF THE GOVERNOR'S APPOINTMENTS OFFICE FAILS TO MAKE AN
APPOINTMENT TO FILL AN OPEN POSITION WITHIN THE TIME LIMITS UNDER
SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE
SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO JOINTLY
APPOINT AN INDIVIDUAL TO FILL THE OPEN POSITION WITHIN 60 DAYS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2006.

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
