- 19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "DEXTROMETHORPHAN PRODUCT" MEANS A

- 21 OF DEXTROMETHORPHAN, ITS SALTS OR OPTICAL ISOMERS, OR SALTS OF OPTICAL

- 23 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT PURCHASE A DEXTROMETHORPHAN PRODUCT

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 October 1, 2006.

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
