1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 - Montgomery County -**  
3 **Kensington Recreation Center**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 to  
5 extend the date by which the County Executive and County Council of  
6 Montgomery County must present evidence that a matching fund will be  
7 provided.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Chapter 204 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2003, as amended by  
10 Chapter 432 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2004  
11 Section 13(3)(i) Item (AM)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Chapter 204 of the Acts of 2003, as amended by Chapter 432 of the Acts of**  
15 **2004**

16 SECTION 13. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

17 (3) (i) \$15,200,000 for the following projects initially approved by the  
18 Senate:

19 (AM) ..... Kensington Recreation Center. Provide a grant equal to the  
20 lesser of (i) \$100,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund  
21 provided, to the County Executive and County Council of  
22 Montgomery County for the acquisition, planning, and design

SENATE BILL 464

1 of the Kensington Recreation Center, located in Kensington.  
 2 Notwithstanding Section 13(5) of this Act, the matching fund  
 3 may consist of real property AND THE GRANTEE MUST  
 4 PRESENT EVIDENCE THAT A MATCHING FUND WILL BE  
 5 PROVIDED BY JUNE 1, 2008 (Montgomery County) .....100,000  
 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
 7 June 1, 2006.
