- 25 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall
- 26 take effect on the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 20 of
- 27 Chapter 289 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002. If that termination provision
- 28 takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
- 29 This Act may not be interpreted to have any effect on that termination provision.
- 30 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the
- 31 appointed members of the Queen Anne's County Board of Education shall expire at
- 32 the end of November 30, 2008.
- 33 SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That before Sections 1 through
- 34 5 of this Act become effective, this Act shall first be submitted to a referendum of the
- 35 legally qualified voters of Queen Anne's County at the general election to be held in
- 36 November of 2006. The cost of the election, if any, shall be paid by the County
- 37 governing body. The County governing body and the County Board of Elections shall

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- 1 do those things necessary and proper to provide for and hold the referendum required
- 2 by this section. There shall be printed on the ballot to be used at this election the title
- 3 of this Act and underneath the title, on separate lines, a square or box opposite the
- 4 words "For a Board of Education Elected by the Voters of Queen Anne's County" and
- 5 a corresponding square or box opposite the words "For a Board of Education
- 6 Appointed by the Governor". A voter may choose only one of the methods of selection.
- 7 If a majority of the votes cast on the question are "For a Board of Education Elected
- 8 by the Voters of Queen Anne's County", Sections 1 through 5 of this Act shall become
- 9 effective on the 30th day following the official canvass of votes for the referendum, but
- 10 if a majority of the votes cast on the question are "For a Board of Education Appointed
- 11 by the Governor", the provisions of this Act are of no effect and null and void.
- 12 SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions
- 13 of Section 6 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 1, 2006.
