- 9 LEGISLATIVE SCHOLARSHIP MAY BE USED ONLY AT AN UNDERGRADUATE,
- 10 GRADUATE, OR PROFESSIONAL SCHOOL IN THE STATE.
- 11 (B) AWARDS MAY BE USED BY RECIPIENTS TO ATTEND ACCREDITED
- 12 UNDERGRADUATE, GRADUATE, OR PROFESSIONAL INSTITUTIONS OUTSIDE THE
- 13 STATE IF THE RECIPIENT IS:
- 14 (1) STUDYING IN AN ACADEMIC AREA THAT IS NOT AVAILABLE AT AN
- 15 INSTITUTION IN THE STATE; OR
- 16 (2) HEARING-IMPAIRED OR DISABLED AND STUDYING AT AN
- 17 INSTITUTION OUT OF THE STATE THAT MAKES SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR HEARING-
- 18 IMPAIRED AND DISABLED STUDENTS, AND COMPARABLE PROVISIONS CANNOT BE
- 19 MADE AT AN INSTITUTION IN THE STATE.

- 21 provisions of this Act, a recipient of a Senatorial Scholarship award or a Delegate
- 22 Scholarship award that is made prior to July 1, 2006, shall continue to be eligible to
- 23 receive the full amount of that scholarship award for the duration of the eligibility
- 24 period applicable to the recipient.

- 26 July 1, 2006.
