

- 1 (2) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A 2 SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- 3 (3) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES 4 ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED
- 5 AND QUALIFIES.
- 6 (4) A MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE FOR MORE THAN TWO CONSECUTIVE 7 3-YEAR TERMS.
- 8 (E) THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER FOR INCOMPETENCE OR 9 MISCONDUCT.
- 10 (F) THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION BUT 11 ARE ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE 12 TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- 13 (G) (1) A MAJORITY OF THE FULL AUTHORIZED MEMBERSHIP OF THE 14 BOARD IS A QUORUM TO DO BUSINESS.
- 15 (2) THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS 16 MEETINGS.
- 17 (H) THE BOARD MAY SET REASONABLE FEES TO PRODUCE FUNDS TO 18 APPROXIMATE THE COST OF CARRYING OUT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- 19 (I) THE BOARD SHALL DEVELOP TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR SECURITY 20 SYSTEMS TECHNICIANS.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 2006.
