MARYLAND INSURANCE COMMISSIONER, AND THE ADJUTANT GENERAL, SHALL
DETERMINE WHETHER THE ACT OF TERRORISM IS A CRIMINAL ACT OR AN ACT OF
WAR FOR PURPOSES OF HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE.
