- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 21 Article Education
- 22 6-112.1.
- 23 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "BOARD" MEANS THE STATE BOARD OF AUDIOLOGISTS,
- 24 HEARING-AID DISPENSERS, AND SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGISTS.
- 25 (B) THERE IS A PROGRAM OF COUNTY AID TO AUDIOLOGISTS AND
- 26 SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGISTS WHO:
- 27 (1) PROVIDE AUDIOLOGY AND SPEECH-LANGUAGE SERVICES ON A
- 28 THIRD-PARTY BILLING BASIS IN SCHOOLS; AND

- 1 (2) ARE LICENSED BY THE BOARD.
- 2 (C) EACH AUDIOLOGIST AND SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST WHO MEETS
- 3 THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL RECEIVE FROM
