4 FOR the purpose of altering the annual license fee in Wicomico County for a Class
5 B-Conference Center license; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages
6 licenses in Wicomico County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

20 6-201.

21 (x) (1) This subsection applies only in Wicomico County.

- 1 (3) (i) There is a Class B-Conference Center license.
- 2 (ii) The annual license fee is [\$1,100] \$1,500.
- 3 (iii) The conference center shall have a minimum capacity of 500
4 persons and the following facilities:
- 5 1. Kitchen;
- 6 2. Dining; and
- 7 3. Meeting space.
- 8 (iv) Licensees may sell beer, wine and liquor for on-premises
9 consumption to persons attending an event at the conference center.
- 10 (v) An existing Class B license may be amended to one for
11 conference center use.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2006.
