1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Wicomico County - Alcoholic Beverages Violations - Maximum Fine**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the maximum fine that the Wicomico County Board of
4 License Commissioners may impose for certain alcoholic beverages violations
5 instead of or in addition to certain other penalties; and generally relating to
6 penalties for alcoholic beverages violations in Wicomico County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

15 16-507.

16 (x) In Wicomico County the Board of License Commissioners may impose a
17 fine of not more than [\$2,000] \$5,000 payable to the local collecting agent or suspend
18 a license or both fine and suspend for any violation that is cause for suspension under
19 the alcoholic beverage laws affecting Wicomico County.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2006.
