A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Medical Assistance Program - Medically Based Child Care**
3 **Centers - Reimbursement**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to
5 reimburse certain medically based child care centers for care provided to
6 Maryland Medical Assistance Program recipients at a certain per diem rate; and
7 generally relating to the Maryland Medical Assistance Program and
8 reimbursement for medically based child care services.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Health - General**

17 15-116.1.

18 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REIMBURSE MEDICALLY BASED CHILD CARE
19 CENTERS THAT PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM FOR CARE PROVIDED TO PROGRAM
20 RECIPIENTS AT A PER DIEM RATE OF AT LEAST \$140.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 July 1, 2006.
