2 **Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses - Residency Requirement**
3 **for Applicants**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the residency requirement for applicants for alcoholic
5 beverages licenses in Harford County; and generally relating to alcoholic
6 beverages licenses in Harford County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

15 10-104.

16 (n) In Harford County, an applicant for an alcoholic beverage license shall be a
17 bona fide resident [at the time of] FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR BEFORE filing the
18 application and shall remain a resident as long as the license is in effect, but does not
19 have to be a registered voter.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2006.
