2 Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages - Beer, Wine and Liquor Tasting 3 License

4 FOR the purpose of altering a certain license to create the Class BWLT beer, wine and

- 5 liquor tasting license in Baltimore County; providing that a Class BWLT license
- 6 may only be issued to a holder of a certain license; repealing <u>altering</u> a certain
- 7 restriction on the maximum number of licenses available each year; establishing
- 8 a certain license fee; specifying that a holder of a Class BWLT license authorizes
- 9 a holder to allow the on-premises consumption of certain alcoholic beverages for
- 10 tasting or sampling purposes; repealing a requirement to dispose of certain
- 11 unconsumed alcoholic beverages; making certain stylistic changes; and
- 12 generally relating to the Class BWLT license in Baltimore County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

3 (a) In Baltimore County, the Board of License Commissioners may issue a
4 1-day Class [BWT beer and wine] BWLT BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR (on-premises)
5 tasting license.

6 f(b) The maximum number of licenses available each year is $\frac{12}{50}$.

7 (c)] (B) A Class [BWT] BWLT license may only be issued to a holder of a 8 [Class A beer and light wine license or a] Class A beer, wine and liquor license.

9 [(d)] (C) (1) The fee for a Class [BWT] BWLT license is [\$10] \$150.

10 (2) The fee for a Class [BWT] BWLT license is in addition to the Class A 11 annual fee.

12 {(e)} (D) The Class [BWT] BWLT license authorizes a holder to [permit]
 13 ALLOW the on-premises consumption of the following alcoholic beverages for tasting
 14 or sampling purposes only:

15 (1) Light wine to be served in a quantity of not more than 1 ounce from 16 each given brand to any [1] ONE person; [and]

17(2)Beer to be served in a quantity of not more than 3 ounces to any [1]18ONE person; AND

19(3)LIQUOR AND DISTILLED SPIRITS IN A QUANTITY OF NOT MORE THAN201 OUNCE TO ANY ONE PERSON.

21 [(f) At the end of the day for which the license is valid, a holder of a 1-day 22 Class BWT license shall dispose of any unconsumed alcoholic beverage remaining in

23 a container that was opened for tasting or sampling.

24 (g)] (E) (F) The provisions of this section are not restricted by:

25 (1) The provisions in § 12-107(b) of this article; and

26 (2) The provisions of law in § 9-102 of this article which prohibit the 27 issuance of [2] TWO licenses for the same premises.

[(h)] (F) (G) The holder may exercise the privileges under the Class [BWT]
BWLT license only during the hours and days provided for under the respective Class
A license.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 October 1, 2006.
