- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing that a certain person who uses deadly force or force
- 4 likely to cause death in the person's residence is presumed for the purpose of

- 21 (A) SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CIVIL LIABILITY, A PERSON WHO USES
- 22 DEADLY FORCE OR FORCE LIKELY TO CAUSE DEATH IN THE PERSON'S RESIDENCE IS
- 23 PRESUMED TO HAVE HELD A REASONABLE FEAR OF IMMINENT PERIL OF DEATH OR
