- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 24 (a) Each circuit court judge shall have one law clerk, to be employed by the
- 25 State.
- 26 The budget for the Administrative Office of the Courts shall include funds
- 27 to employ one law clerk for each circuit court judge.
