2 **Election Law - Baltimore County Republican Central Committee**

3 FOR the purpose of altering provisions for the election of members of the Baltimore
4 County Republican Central Committee; specifying that certain members shall
5 be elected from each of the legislative districts of the county and certain
6 members shall be elected from the county at large; and generally relating to the
7 Baltimore County Republican Central Committee.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Election Law**

16 4-203.

17 (c) (2) The Republican Party Central Committee shall consist of:

18 (i) [four] THREE members elected from each [councilmanic]
19 LEGISLATIVE district in the county;

20 (II) FOUR MEMBERS ELECTED FROM THE COUNTY AT LARGE; and

21 [(ii)] (III) a chairman elected from the county at large.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 July 1, 2006.
