15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A MEDICAL
20 LABORATORY FOR WHICH A LICENSE HAS BEEN ISSUED SHALL CALCULATE THE
21 ESTIMATED GLOMERULAR FILTRATION RATE:

(1) IF AN AUTHORIZED HEALTH CARE PROVIDER ORDERS OR
PRESCRIBES A TEST FOR THE SERUM CREATININE LEVEL FOR AN INDIVIDUAL AT
LEAST 18 YEARS OLD; AND
