- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Chapter 389 of the Acts of 1984, as amended by Chapter 138 of the Acts of 1985 and Chapter 28 of the Acts of 2004
- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That:
- 17 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 18 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Redhouse
- 19 Run Stormwater Systems Loan of 1984 in the aggregate principal amount of
- 20 \$3,000,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance and sale of State general
- 21 obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued,
- 22 sold and delivered in accordance with the provisions of §§ 19 to 23 of Article 31 of the
- 23 Annotated Code of Maryland (1983 Replacement Volume, as amended from time to
- 24 time).
- 25 (2) The bonds issued to evidence this loan or installments thereof may be sold
- 26 as a single issue, or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds
- 27 under § 2B of Article 31 of the Code.
- 28 (3) The actual cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the
- 29 Treasurer and shall be first applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing and

- 1 delivering the bonds unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided and
- 2 thereafter shall be credited on the books of the State Comptroller and expended, upon
- 3 approval by the Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including
- 4 any applicable architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the County Executive and
- 5 County Council of Baltimore County for the purpose of the reconstruction,
- 6 rehabilitation, renovation, reequipping, restoration, and improvement of the
- 7 stormwater systems along Redhouse Run in Baltimore County.
- 8 (4) There is hereby levied and imposed an annual State tax on all assessable
- 9 property in the State in rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest
- 10 on the bonds as and when due and until paid in full, such principal to be discharged
- 11 within fifteen years of the date of issue of the bonds.
- 12 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 13 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the County Executive and County Council of
- 14 Baltimore County shall provide at least an equal and matching fund of \$3,000,000. No
- 15 part of an applicant's matching fund may be provided, either directly or indirectly,
- 16 from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the fund
- 17 may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the
- 18 effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to what money or assets may
- 19 qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and
- 20 the Board's decision is final. The County Executive and County Council of Baltimore
- 21 County have until June 1, 1987, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of
- 22 Public Works that the matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is
- 23 presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State Treasurer and the proceeds of
- 24 the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. If this evidence is not
- 25 presented by June 1, 1987, the proceeds of the loan shall be applied to the purposes
- 26 authorized in Article 78A, § 3 of the Code.
- 27 (6) The proceeds of the loan must be encumbered by the Board of Public Works
- 28 or expended for the purposes provided in this Act no later than June 1, [2006] 2007.
- 29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 June 1, 2006.
