A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Counties and Baltimore City - Inspectors General - Subpoena Power and**
3 **Judicial Enforcement**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a county that has established a certain Office of
5 Inspector General to enact a local law or ordinance that authorizes a certain
6 Inspector General to issue a subpoena for certain purposes under certain
7 circumstances and to petition a certain circuit court to enforce a certain
8 subpoena; and generally relating to the authorization by a county for an
9 Inspector General to issue subpoenas and provide for enforcement of the
10 subpoenas.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions**

19 TITLE 5. OFFICES OF INSPECTORS GENERAL.

20 5-101.

21 A COUNTY THAT HAS ESTABLISHED, EITHER BY ORDINANCE OR BY EXECUTIVE
22 ORDER, AN OFFICE OF INSPECTOR GENERAL MAY ENACT A LOCAL LAW OR
23 ORDINANCE THAT AUTHORIZES THE INSPECTOR GENERAL TO:

24 (1) ISSUE A SUBPOENA TO REQUIRE ANY PERSON TO APPEAR UNDER
25 OATH AS A WITNESS OR PRODUCE ANY RECORD OR OTHER MATERIAL IN
26 CONNECTION WITH AN AUDIT OR INVESTIGATION OF THE OFFICE OF INSPECTOR
27 GENERAL; AND

1 (2) FILE A PETITION FOR ENFORCEMENT OF A SUBPOENA, ISSUED IN
2 ACCORDANCE WITH THE LOCAL LAW OR ORDINANCE, WITH THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR
3 THE COUNTY.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 October 1, 2006.
