A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 1999 - Local Jails and**  
3 **Detention Centers - Anne Arundel County Detention Center**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 1999,  
5 to allow the matching fund for the Local Jails and Detention Centers - Anne  
6 Arundel County Detention Center project to include funds expended prior to a  
7 certain date, but after a certain date; expanding the authorized uses of the loan  
8 proceeds and matching fund; providing that the authorization shall not  
9 terminate before a certain date; and generally relating to the Anne Arundel  
10 County Detention Centers.

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
12 Chapter 212 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1999

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 (A) Anne Arundel County Detention Center. Provide a grant to the  
22 County Executive and County Council of Anne Arundel County

24 County Detention Center on Jennifer Road, AND THE DESIGN,  
25 CONSTRUCTION, AND CAPITAL EQUIPPING OF THE ANNE  
26 ARUNDEL COUNTY DETENTION CENTER ANNEX ON ORDNANCE  
27 ROAD, subject to the requirement that the grantee provide an  
28 equal and matching fund for this purpose. Notwithstanding the  
29 provisions of Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund may

1 include funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act,  
 2 BUT AFTER JUNE 1, 1993. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER  
 3 PROVISION OF LAW, THIS AUTHORIZATION SHALL NOT  
 4 TERMINATE PRIOR TO JUNE 1, 2007 (Anne Arundel County)..... 1,904,000

 6 June 1, 2006.
