- 1 (1) SHALL exercise due care to avoid colliding with any bicycle, EPAMD, 2 or motor scooter being ridden by a person; AND
- 3 (2) MAY NOT INTENTIONALLY INTERFERE WITH THE MOVEMENT OF A 4 PERSON WHO IS RIDING A BICYCLE, AN EPAMD, OR A MOTOR SCOOTER.
- 5 (b) A person may not throw any object at or in the direction of any person 6 riding a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter.
- 7 (c) A person may not open the door of any motor vehicle with intent to strike, 8 injure, or interfere with any person riding a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter.
